- Experience with managing Enterprise File Sharing and Sync
- Experience with managing Microsoft SQL Server or enterprise database servers
- Experience with managing Active Directory and Group Policy
- Basic Networking including understanding of VPN concepts, SSL encryption and certificates.

It is also recommended that students bring a mobile device (iPhone or Android) to complete device enrollment and Worx-related exercises. This device should not be enrolled in another MDM solution, or would need to be unenrolled in order to use it to complete the mobile device-specific class exercises.
